 There is a cat on the wardrobe.
- 3 In picture 1 there are three CDs in the box, but in picture 2 there aren't three CDs in the box.

 There are ten CDs.

There is / There are

• We use there is before singular nouns.

Affirmative	There is (There's)	There is a car in the street.
Negative	There is not (There isn't)	There isn't a sofa in the bedroom.
Interrogative	Is there?	Is there a lamp on your desk? Yes, there is. No, there isn't.

• We use there are before plural nouns.

Affirmative	There are	There are four rooms in the house.
Negative	There are not (There aren't)	There aren't two bedrooms in the house.
Interrogative	Are there?	Are there two vases on the table? Yes, there are. No, there aren't.

Note:

There is a table in the kitchen. (We say that something exists.) It's a big table. (We give information about it.)

There are three chairs in your room.

They are old chairs. NOT There are old chairs.

Prepositions of Place (in-on-under-near)

Prepositions of place show where someone or something is.




